Your visit

Barryland offers an immersive and interactive experience in the heart of the St. Bernard universe. Thanks to its modern setting and spacious indoor and outdoor areas, guests can enjoy a smooth and comfortable visit while respecting the well-being of the dogs. Many fascinating activities await for a unique adventure up close to these legendary canines.

Outdoor activities

- Vast runs: watch the dogs or interact with them under the supervision of the dog keepers.
- Stroll around the grounds: explore the diverse countryside recreating the natural environments of St. Bernards: mountains, orchard, woodland, meadows and wetland.
- Les Jardins de Brigitte: a unique garden with fragrant, medicinal plants and vegetables from Roman times, as well as animals such as sheep, goats and chickens.
- Play area: outdoor play equipment to entertain the kids.
- Snack and picnic area: refuel in the heart of nature.

Indoor activities

- Immersive diorama: dive into the myths and legends of Barry with a spectacular sound and light show.
- Photo spot: create an unforgettable memory against this unique backdrop.
- Rich multimedia content: discover the history of St. Bernards through enthralling screenings.
- Interactive experiences: explore the region of origin of St. Bernards through an interactive model, augmented reality headsets and a virtual reality panoramic telescope.
- Infinity Room: a 360° audio-visual experience: totally immerse yourself alone or in a small group in the mountainous birthplace of the St. Bernard.

Pricing conditions

- Size of group: min. 10 people. Meet & greet with the dogs: max. 20 people per group (larger groups must be split).
- Drinks are not included in the menu price.
- Meet & greets with the dogs are subject to availability and are limited to a set number per day.
- Meet & greets with the dogs may be cancelled if the group is late (no refund).
- Visitors always meet the dogs under the supervision of Barryland staff whose instructions must be followed at all times. Inappropriate conduct can result in immediate expulsion from the meet & greet.

- Opening hours: daily 10 a.m. – 6 p.m., except 24 and 25 December.
- Barry Shop: large souvenir shop with many items relating to St. Bernards and Valais.
- Conference rooms: 3 seminar rooms with audiovisual equipment, can hold 15 to 70 people.
